

QUALITY CNA TRAINING (QCNAT) FINAL EXAM INFORMATION

Here's what you need to know about the QCNAT Final Exam via Zoom:

- Please make sure to sign on 20 minutes early with a government-issued ID such as a passport, state ID, or driver's license.
- You'll need two devices: one for Zoom and one for Google Classroom. If possible, we recommend using a phone and a computer.
- You must be in scrubs and sitting in a professional manner. Laying on your bed in your PJ's is not acceptable.
- Make sure you're in a quiet room with a good internet connection, and that you're alone, as you will be unmuted for the call.

QCNAT Final Exam Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: Where can I find the Zoom link?

- A: You can find the same Zoom link we used on the first day of class in Google Classroom or in the confirmation email you received.

Q: What happens if I fail A and B?

- A: If you fail A and B, you will have to repay, re-enroll, and restart the class.

Q: What if my internet connection is lost?

- A: We give students a minute or two to reconnect and get back on track.

Q: What kind of accommodations can I request?

- A: You can ask to have the test read to you, but you must schedule a one-on-one time for this.

Q: Are notes or calculators allowed?

- A: No, they are not allowed.

Q: How many questions are there?

- A: There are 50 questions.

Q: What score do I need to pass?

- A: You need to score 80% or higher to pass.

QCNAT GRADUATION INFORMATION

“What should I expect for graduation?”

- Bring any outstanding fees (state exam fee if needed, extension fees, makeup time fees)
- Make sure your TMU account has been updated with your personal information
- On graduation day, we will explain to you how to schedule your state knowledge exam through your TMU account. This will be done after we register you for your skills exam.
- QCNAT will register you for your skills test and you will receive your confirmation.

QCNAT Graduation Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: What if I don't bring the testing fee money?

- A: You will still graduate from the class, but you will have to schedule your test.

Q: What if I don't bring in my makeup or extension fee money?

- A: You will not graduate from the class until the fees are paid.

Q: What forms of payment do you accept?

- A: We accept cash, money order, and cashier's check. Personal checks are not accepted.

Q: What if I can't test on the date provided?

- A: You would need to schedule your own test around your availability but we can help guide you.

STATE EXAM SKILLS TEST

Instructions for the day of your State Skills Exam:

- Arrive 20 minutes early with your government-issued ID (passport, state ID, or driver's license)
- YOU MUST BE IN SCRUBS
- Results will be sent through your TMU account within 24-72 hours
- Results can also be found by logging into your personal TMU account.

State Skills Exam Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: What happens if I arrive late?

- A: If you arrive late, you will automatically fail the exam. You will have to reschedule, repay, and take the exam at a future date. The cost to retake or reschedule your skills exam is \$93.00.

Q: What should I do if I don't have my government-issued ID?

- A: If you don't have your government-issued ID, you will not be allowed to take the exam. It will result in an automatic fail, and you will have to reschedule, repay, and take the exam at a future date.

Q: How much time do I have to complete all the skills required for the exam?

- A: You have 30 minutes to complete all the skills required for the exam.

Q: Whom should I contact if I have any questions about the exam?

- A: If you have any questions about the exam, please contact Headmaster at 1-888-401-0462.

Q: What happens if I fail the exam?

- A: If you fail the exam, you will need to pay Headmaster directly through your TMU account to retake the test. You will also be able to immediately schedule yourself for a new testing date and location.

Q: How long do I have to pass my state exams?

- A: You have exactly 365 days from the your graduation day to pass your state exams.

STATE KNOWLEDGE EXAM

What you need to know about the State Knowledge Exam:

- Headmaster will email you a new Zoom link and password. This link will **NOT** be the same link used by QCNAT for orientation or the QCNAT final exam.
- The test will be taken through your TMU account, not on Google Classroom.

- Sign in 20 minutes before the test starts with your government-issued ID (passport, state ID, or driver's license).
- You will need two devices: one for Zoom and one for TMU. We suggest using a phone and a computer or tablet.
- Take the test in a quiet room with a good internet connection and make sure no one else is in the room with you as you will be unmuted for the entire call.
- The results may take up to 48 hours to be posted to the TMU account.
- You must be in scrubs and sitting in a professional manner. Laying on your bed in your PJ's is not acceptable.

State Knowledge Exam Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Q: What happens if I arrive late?

- A: If you arrive late to the test, you will automatically fail and have to repay, reschedule, and take the test at a future time. The cost to retake or reschedule your state knowledge exam is \$32 or \$37 if taking the oral exam.

Q: What if I don't have my government-issued ID?

- A: If you don't have your government-issued ID, you will automatically fail and have to repay, reschedule, and take the test at a future time.

Q: How long do I have to complete the test?

- A: You have one hour to complete the test.

Q: How many questions are on the test?

- A: The test consists of 75 questions. Students taking the oral exam are read the first 67 questions by a computer-generated voice and must read the remaining 8 question to test your reading comprehension.

Q: What score do I need to pass?

- A: To pass the test, you need to score 71% or better.

Q: Are notes or calculators allowed? A: No, notes or calculators are not allowed during the test.

Q: When will I get the Zoom link?

- A: You will receive the Zoom link the night before the test.

Q: Can the knowledge test be given in a foreign language?

- A: All students must take the English version of the exam but a paper version of a word for word translation book can be used.

Q: What will occur if I fail the exam?

- A: You may retake the test by paying the fee as many times as required.

Q: What is the time limit for passing my state exams?

- A: You have 365 days from the date of your graduation to pass.
